

APRIL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Columbus Foundation Scholarships - Numerous scholarships offered that are administered by Columbus Foundation, a non-profit organization. Log on to www.columbusfoundation.org, click on "Students" at the bottom. Use the links on the website to get specific scholarship information and applications. **Application deadlines vary.**

Association of Government Accountants Scholarship – Columbus Chapter – Offers a \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior who plan to major in a financial management academic discipline (include accounting, budgeting, economics, finance, and others). Based on academics, reference and essay. C.R. Meyers Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000 Scholarship offered by Ohio Association of Litter Prevent and Recycling Professionals to a senior planning to major in environmental science/education. Requires application, letter of recommendation, school and community involvement, and an essay describing attitude toward litter prevention, recycling and environmental stewardship. Go to <http://oalprp.org/scholarships/>. Application is due by **April 15.**

Keller Family Chiropractic LLC Alternative Health Care Scholarship - Offers one \$500 scholarship for a graduating senior of a Fairfield County high school who is interested in an alternative health care career (chiropractic, homeopathy, massage therapy, naturopathy, etc.) May be used for educational purposes at any accredited school. Selection is based on grades, activities, need and an essay. Application deadline is **April 15**

Lancaster Business and Professional Women’s Association Scholarship – Offers a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduate of a Fairfield County high school. Based on academics, service, and educational/career goals. Application deadline is **5 PM on April 17.**

Pleasantville LaSertoma – seeking students to nominate for a \$1,000 scholarship based on need (60%), scholastic achievement, community involvement and leadership, and future plans. Application is available in the counselor’s office, and deadline is **April 20.**

Student-View Scholarship Program - Offers several scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$4,000 for students planning to attend a four-year college, community college, or career school. Log on to www.student-view.com, and complete a 20 minute application survey. Winners will be determined by a random drawing of participants. Application deadline is **April 22.**

Fairfield County Medical Alliance Scholarship – Offers scholarships to Fairfield County students who are pursuing a degree in nursing. Requires 3.0 GPA, and is based on letters of recommendation, essay, activities and awards. Application deadline is **April 29.**

***Jack Anson Memorial Soccer Scholarship** – Awards \$250 scholarship to a senior who played soccer for BCHS during their high school career. Essay required. Information was passed out at soccer banquets, but if you need another copy, contact Mrs. Anson. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Alumni Scholar Athlete** – Will award two \$1,000 scholarships (one to a male, one to a female) based on major achievements in academics, athletics, leadership, service and need. Students who are eligible for the Wagnall’s scholarships are not eligible. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Athletic Boosters Scholarship** - Two \$1,000 scholarships available, one to a male and one to a female athlete. Application requires three letters in one sport or four letters in two, and 500-word essay. Applicant cannot have received an athletic scholarship, or any full tuition scholarship of any kind. Contact the Athletic Department or Guidance Office for applications. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Athletic Memorial Award** – At least one \$500 scholarship offered to a senior who is a varsity letter winner with a 2.5 minimum GPA. Application requires recommendation from principal and one varsity coach. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Education Association Scholarship** – Two \$250 scholarships are offered. Application requires 3.0 GPA, short essay and two recommendations. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***BCHS Scholarship** - Offers one \$500 scholarship to a student who plans a career in the field of education. Application requires 2.0 GPA, short essay, and two recommendations. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Lions Scholarship** - Two \$500 scholarships are offered to students who have resided in the District for at least four years. Award is based primarily on community service as described in a 500-word essay. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Bloom-Carroll Music Boosters Scholarship** - Offers one \$500 scholarship to a student whom is a current member in at least one high school music organization, has participated in Booster fundraising events, and planning to continue education in performing arts or music education. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Carroll Lions Scholarship** - Offers two \$500 scholarships. Student must have resided in the School District for at least four years. Award is based primarily on community service as described in a 500-word essay, and academics. Preference on one may be given to a student participating in a program leading to certification or licensure. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Carroll and Bloom-Carroll Alumni Association Scholarship** - Will award one \$500 scholarship to a graduating senior. Requires 2.5 GPA, *cannot* have received a full tuition scholarship, must have attended BCHS for past four years, and must attend Alumni banquet in June in order to receive the scholarship. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Leah Jackson Memorial Scholarship** - At least one \$500 scholarship to at least one graduating senior. Minimum 2.5 to 3.5 GPA. Though not required, being a cheerleader will be a consideration. Based on academics, athletics, and high school and community service and activities. Application deadline is **May 1.**

Kiwanis Club of Lancaster Scholarship – Will offer one scholarship of \$500 to a BCHS Key Club senior. Selection is based on Community Service and work experience. Personal statement is also required. Applications are available from Mr. Gaulke or Mr. Bookman. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Christopher Miller Memorial Scholarship** – Will award one scholarship of \$250 to an Eagle Scout from Troop 241 or Troop 258 to the recipient's college of choice. Includes essay and proof of earning Eagle award. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Wendell Miller BC Softball Scholarship** – One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a BCHS senior. Requires 2.5 GPA, based on school and community activities. Application deadline is **May 1.**

***Jessie Woods Inspirational Scholarship** - Two \$250 scholarships to be awarded to seniors with minimum 3.0 GPA, attended BCHS for at least the past two years, and have at least one varsity letter. Application requires essay and two letters of recommendation. Application deadline is **May 1.**

Ohio News Media Foundation Minority Scholarship - Offers multiple \$1,250 scholarships to high school seniors who plan to major in a field relevant to the newspaper industry. Requires 2.5 GPA, essay, and recommendations. Application and more details, including accepted majors, are available at <https://www.ohionews.org/aws/ONA/pt/sp/scholarships>. Application deadline is **May 15**.

B. Davis Scholarship - Awards one \$1,000 scholarship through an on-line essay competition. Essay must be submitted by email. Website is www.studentawardsearch.com/scholarships.htm for more information. Application deadline is **May 22**.

Christian Connector Scholarship Drawing - Students who register for information on this Christian college information service are automatically entered for a \$2,500 scholarship drawing. Also serves as a source of information for over \$150 million in scholarships to Christian colleges. Students may sign up at the search website, www.christianconnector.com. Scholarship contest runs through **May 31**. Or use the “Scholarship Resources” link at the top of the page to get information on specific scholarships.

Abbott and Fenner Scholarships –Awards one \$1,000 scholarship. Requires an essay, submitted via email. Application/information is available online at www.abbottandfenner.com, then click on the “Scholarships” tab at the top. Application deadline is **June 12**.

Horatio Alger Association Career and Technical Scholarships – Will award up to 1020 scholarships in various amounts, up to \$2,500. Must be planning on attending a community college or technical school in the fall, and be Pell Grant eligible based on the FAFSA. Apply online at www.scholarship.horatioalger.org, and click on the “Scholarship” tab at the top of the page. Application deadline is **June 15**.

Lucidpress.com Scholarships – Sponsors two \$1,000 scholarships using their online products, based on writing prompts from the Common Application. Go to <https://lucidpress.com/pages/scholarship> or <https://lucidchart.com/pages/scholarship> to create and enter your submission. Application deadline is **June 16**.

Big Sun Scholarship – At least one scholarship of \$500 will be awarded to a high school student-athlete. Requires essay submission via email. Apply online at www.bigsunathletics.com. Application deadline is **June 19**.

Injury Doctor Scholarship – One-time scholarship of \$1,000 to a student who plans to enter the medical field. Requires 3.0 GPA, need, and 500 word essay on why student is interested in medical careers. Go to <https://www.injuredcalltoday.com/#scholarship-application>. Application deadline is **June 30**.

El Dabe Ritter Scholarship – Offers one scholarship of \$1,500 to a graduating senior. Requires 3.0 GPA. Selection based on academics, leadership and essay. Application is available online at <https://www.personalinjurylawyerslosangeles.com/#scholarship>. Application deadline is **June 30**.

GoTranscript Academic Scholarship Program – Offers \$1,000 scholarship. Requires essay submission on multiple prompts. Information and submission at <https://gotranscript.com/scholarship-program>. Two winners picked each year. Submission is accepted year-round.

Athnet Sports Recruiting Scholarship – Offers a \$1,000 scholarship to students who were athletes in high school. Requires 400 – 500 word essay submitted via email. For specifics, go to www.athleticscholarships.net/scholarship-contest.htm. Application deadline is **July 1**.

City Property Management HOA Service Scholarship - \$1,000 scholarship offered to a student based on merit, need, and leadership. Recommendations and resume not required but encouraged. Requires 3.0 GPA. Go to www.cityproperty.com/phoenix#scholarship-link, click on the scholarship banner near the bottom of the page. Application deadline is **July 31**.

Sapling HR Scholarship - \$1,000 scholarship offered for a student who intends to major in a Human Resources or related major. Requires online submission of a maximum 600 word essay related to an onboarding program for new employees of a company. Rules and other information are available at <https://www.saplinghr.com/about/scholarship>. Application deadline is **November 1**.

Dirk Derrick Car and Truck Accident Injury Scholarship – Will award \$1,000 scholarship to a student who has had his or her life altered due to an injury from a car or truck accident. Can relate to the student or a loved one. Based on essay conveying the lasting effect of the accident on their life, and journey to overcome those challenges.
