

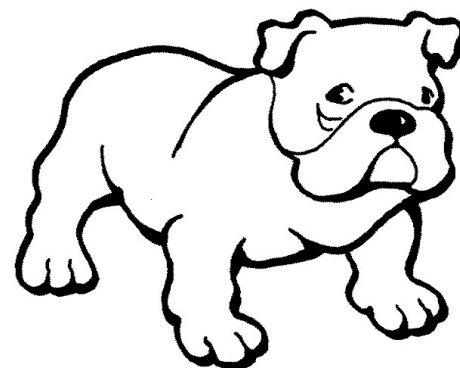

Teacher Requests 2021-2022 School Year

The window to access the Teacher Request Form will open on Thursday, April 1, 2021 at 8:30 A.M. The window will close on Saturday, May 1, 2021 at 3:30 P.M.

Parents/guardians can go the Bloom-Carroll district webpage, click on "Forms", scroll down to the Intermediate School, and click on the "Teacher Request Form". The form can be completed online. When you click on the "submit" button, it will email the form to the building principal.

When completing the form, you must provide a reason for your request. Applying for a teacher request does not guarantee that the placement will be made. We consider the class size, boy/girl ratio, and other factors as we strive to create the best learning environment. We will **not** send a teacher request form home with your child.

Safety

As warmer weather approaches and students are outside more, it is important to remember health and safety.
