## **Nurse News**

### **Safety**

As warmer weather approaches and students are outside more, it is important to remember health and safety. Per the CDC (2021), wearing a helmet that fits when riding a bike and following playground rules to assure safety. Also, wearing a seatbelt and/or sitting in the best seat for the child (car seat, booster seat) and buckling up while riding in the vehicle on every trip can “reduces serious and fatal injuries by up to 80 per-cent” (CDC, 2021).

### **Hydration and the Sun’s rays**

Remember to bring a water container to school to stay hydrated especially during warmer months. Sunburn can occur even during cloudy days- the CDC (2021), “recommends sunscreen be worn when outside, the sun’s rays are highest between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.”.
