Safe Return of In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan

6/11/2021

Governor DeWine has requested that schools districts design plans that address the safe return to in-person instruction and continuity of services to meet the needs of students for the 21-22 school year.

The Bloom-Carroll Local School District has been providing face-to-face instruction, five days a week, to our students since October 5, 2020. We have maintained the same standard of high expectations as in previous years. We consistently monitor student progress and use all available data to make decisions that support individual student needs. We have prioritized the social and emotional well-being of our students during the pandemic and are providing supports where appropriate. Therefore we will continue to provide face-to-face instruction, five days a week, to our students during the 2021-2022 academic year.

These general principles will guide our school community as we continue services in the Bloom-Carroll Local School District.

1. Our school district will implement recommended safety protocols to the highest degree possible, while also considering the instructional, behavioral, and social-emotional needs of students. On June 2, 2021, Governor DeWine and the ODH rescinded the K-12 school facial coverings order. Students, staff, and guests may continue to wear a facial covering.
2. Our school district will work closely with the Fairfield Department of Health to promote health and safety in all school buildings.
3. Our school district will be transparent with all stakeholders that some level of risk will always be present when children, employees, and guests occupy school district facilities.
4. Our school district recognizes the need for consistency in areas of operations while also recognizing that individual differences in classroom sizes, school facilities and building operations may lead to some inconsistencies.
