- 2) The Bloom-Carroll student acting as the host is responsible for the quests' compliance with all Bloom-Carroll Dance/event rules and Code of Conduct. You and your quest are considered a couple. BCHS Students attending homecoming, (grades 9-12), or attending prom (grades 11-12), are only permitted to bring one (1) quest for the event.
- 3) No middle school student will be permitted to attend.
- 4) No person over the age of 20 will be admitted (see item #1 above)
- 5) If the quest is currently enrolled at another high school, the signature of the principal is required as an indication of the student being in 'good standing' at his/her current school.
- 6) If the guest is a minor, the signature of the parent/guardian is required as an indication of their acceptance of the Bloom-Carroll school rules and support of these expectations
- 7) The Administration of Bloom-Carroll High School reserves the right to revoke these privileges and remove the guest from the premises if deemed necessary. No refund will be given.
- 8) School dances are intended to provide a positive and enjoyable atmosphere for our students.
