

Letter from the Nurse

Fall is upon us and with this season comes coughs, runny noses, fevers, etc. I wanted to make sure to go over the school policy when it comes to illnesses. Students should remain home if they have experienced in the last 24 hours: diarrhea, fever >100.0, vomiting. Children should remain free of fever for 24 hours without fever reducing medications before returning to school. If a child is placed on antibiotic therapy by their medical provider, they need to have had a full 24 hours of medication prior to returning to school.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (2018), there are ways to help prevent and/or reduce chances of illness, such as, Flu vaccine, hand washing, and remaining home when you are ill as to prevent spreading illness to others.

Flu symptoms: "fever* or feeling feverish/chills, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headaches, fatigue (tiredness), some people may have vomiting and diarrhea, though this is more common in children than adults. *It's important to note that not everyone with flu will have a fever." (CDC, 2018).
