Step 3 - 250 Word Essay (100 Points)

The essay must include the following:

- Why you want to be a member of the BCMS OMUN?
- What qualities do you have that will make you a good team member?
- What do you expect to get out of being a member of BCMS OMUN

Step 4 – Teacher Recommendations (60 Total Points, 20 Points Each)

You need to ask 3 CURRENT TEACHERS to complete the recommendation forms. You must tear off the forms and have the teachers fill them out. On each form, the directions state that the recommending teacher will return the completed form to Mrs. Butcher. (These can be scanned and emailed to me.) Students, please do not give the recommending teacher the entire packet. You will be turning in the packet separately from the recommendation forms.

Step 5 - Turn It In On Time

Make sure you complete the application on time! All applications must be completed and turned in by the end of the school day on Friday September 20^{th, 2019}. Late applications will not be accepted.
