Student Assessments

Kindergarten, First, and Second Grade students will be taking a computer based assessment in Math and Reading. The program is called "MAP," Measuring Academic Progress. All students will be given a one on one reading assessment with their teacher called the "DRA," Developmental Reading Assessment. This will allow the teachers to instruct at the specific reading level of your student. Expected levels for the year are listed below. All assessments are given three times: beginning of the year, mid-year, and end of year. Teachers will send home the data after each assessment check.

Students have also taken or will be taking the Lexia Placement assessment that addresses several components of Language Arts.
